

Unlisted Procedure/Investigation/Implant/Restricted Medicine

A. For Planned Unlisted Cases - for a Planned Unlisted Procedure/Investigation/Implant/ restricted medicine the following documents are required to be submitted by Air India Retiree/CGHS beneficiaries. Documents should be clear, readable and should be in hospital letterhead.

1. Brief clinical history/details along with Doctors' prescription
2. Reports of all tests related to diagnosis/disease.
3. Clear Scanned Images of x-ray/CT scan/MRI/CD etc. related to diagnosis/ disease
4. Estimate/Dealer's/Purchase Invoice of Unlisted Procedure/Investigation/Implant/Restricted Medicine with break up details.
5. Justification letter from the treating consultant/Surgeon
6. Copy of Referral Letter from CGHS wellness Centre
7. Copy of CGHS Card
8. Copy of Air India ID Card (for self).
9. Discharge Summary (for ex post facto approval)
10. Post - Op images (for ex post facto approval)

As per CGHS For Unlisted Procedure/Investigation/Implant/ Restricted Medicine etc STC's (Standing Technical Committee) approval is required. Such cases are referred to CGHS to obtain expert's opinion on the scheduled date of that speciality as fixed by CGHS HQ)

B. For Emergency Cases - For Emergency Cases No prior approval is required, all documents as mentioned above (1-10) can be submitted post procedure for ex post facto approval from STC, CGHS.
